Day 1 Arrive in Calgary – August 13, 2017

Welcome to Calgary! Upon arrival, meet your tour manager and transfer to your Calgary accommodations. This Overnight – Hotel Blackfoot (Includes Private room for meals)



Day 2 Calgary to Banff – August 14, 2017

Today starts with a city highlights tour including Chinatown, Scotsman Hill, Stephen Avenue, Olympic Park and more. Visit Calgary's famous Heritage Park, the largest living history attraction in Canada. Take a walk through Gasoline Alley, visit the Historical Village, chat with costumed characters and take a turn on some classic rides like the whip or the ferris wheel. Later today after Dinner, leave the city



behind and begin making your way to Banff, home of Canada's first National Park and your home for the next two nights. Overnight – Fox Hotel & Suites

Day 3 Banff Sightseeing – August 15, 2017

Explore Banff on a sightseeing tour with stops beautiful Bow Falls, Moraine Lake, Lake Louise and much more. Ride the gondola up Sulphur Mountain for panoramic views of the mountains and valley below. Also included is time at Cave and Basin National Historic which tells the story of the hot springs that drew visitors to Banff National Park in the first place. Overnight – Fox Hotel & Suites



Day 4 Banff to Hinton Sightseeing- August 16, 2017
Today travel through the heart of the Canadian Rockies along the renowned Icefields Parkway, voted one of the most scenic drives in the world. Follow the winding road that boasts a unique and irreplaceable landscape rich in history and natural beauty, second to none. At the summit of Bow Pass see the baby blue waters of Peyto Lake and Mistaya River Valley below. Arrive at the famous Columbia Icefields whose waters feed three oceans. Visit the Interpretive Centre then have the experience of a lifetime, a ride on the Ice Explorer for an up close look at the Athabasca Glacier. Visit the powerful and breathtaking Athabasca Falls before arriving in Hinton for the night.

Day 5 Hinton to Kamloops – August 17, 2017
The journey into British Columbia begins this morning. A stop is made at Mount Robson, the highest peak in the Canadian Rockies. An unforgettable highlight today is a River Safari ride through Grizzly Bear Valley, right in the heart of the world's only inland temperate rainforest. Observe bears and other wildlife in their natural environment, without the constraints of gates and cages, from the safety of a boat mid river, presenting the optimum opportunity for the perfect snapshot. Your destination today is Kamloops.
Overnight – Four Points by Sheraton Kamloops



Day 6 Kamloops to Vancouver – August 18, 2017
Today travel the fertile Fraser Valley through the Coast Mountains and into the rugged BC Interior. Along the way, a stop is made at Hell's Gate Airtram for an amazing Fraser Canyon experience. Also enjoy the suspension bridge, observation decks, and fisheries exhibit. Your destination today is Vancouver, a vibrant metropolitan city nestled between majestic mountains, sparkling ocean and rainforest. Visit Capilano Park and experience the suspension bridge, the tree top adventure and cliff walk plus Salish Nations Culture.

ride to the Vancouver Lookout for stunning, unobstructed views of picture-perfect Vancouver. The tour comes to a close upon arrival at Canada Place Terminal where you will embark on an amazing cruise to Anchorage (own arrangements).

Spend the entire day cruising the Inside Passage, one of the worlds' famous waterways.


Day 10, Tuesday: Ketchikan


Day 11, Wednesday: – Juneau


Day 12, Thursday: Skagway

Skagway was established in 1897 as a trading post for prospectors headed to the Klondike Gold Rush, Skagway was once known as "hell on earth," an untamed, violent town controlled by organized criminals. Today, of course, the town is more civilized, though its colorful past is carefully preserved in the Klondike Gold Rush.



Day 13, Friday: Glacier Bay National Park

Early this morning your cruise ship enters the iceberg-strewn waters of Glacier Bay National Park, where thirteen spectacular glaciers flow from surrounding mountains into the waters of the bay. A National Park Service Ranger will help you spot wildlife, while pointing out sights and explaining glacier activity. Perhaps you will be lucky enough to see a pinnacle of ice 'calve' or break away from the face of the glacier and with a thunderous boom, land in the bay.




Day 14, Shabbat: The Inside Passage
